

Webinar on Evolving Ecosystem for AI: Implications for Consumers

Technology-led transformations such as Artificial Intelligence (AI) have brought dynamic changes across sectors in both the services offered and consumption patterns. However, developing countries such as India, grapple with unique challenges, such as: consumers under-capacity to understand the functioning and effects of AI, information asymmetry, inadequate privacy regulations and consumer protection laws, lack of transparency and accountability of service providers, etc. Furthermore, such issues may get aggravated in a post Covid-19 world, given the increasing reliance on digital tools and technology.

In this vein, the webinar envisages to engage stakeholders such as parliamentarians and experts to understand such challenges that emanate from the use of AI, and recommend a way forward for India, which is increasingly strategizing its use in the sectors like education, agriculture, healthcare, etc.
