Digital transactions in India have risen manifold in the past few years. However, the stringent deadline of the RBI circular dated September 07, 2021, 'Tokenisation – Card Transactions: Permitting Card-on-File Tokenisation (CoFT) Services', read with the 'Guidelines on Regulation of Payment Aggregators and Payment Gateways,' may derail this spiralling growth and potentially be detrimental to consumers.
