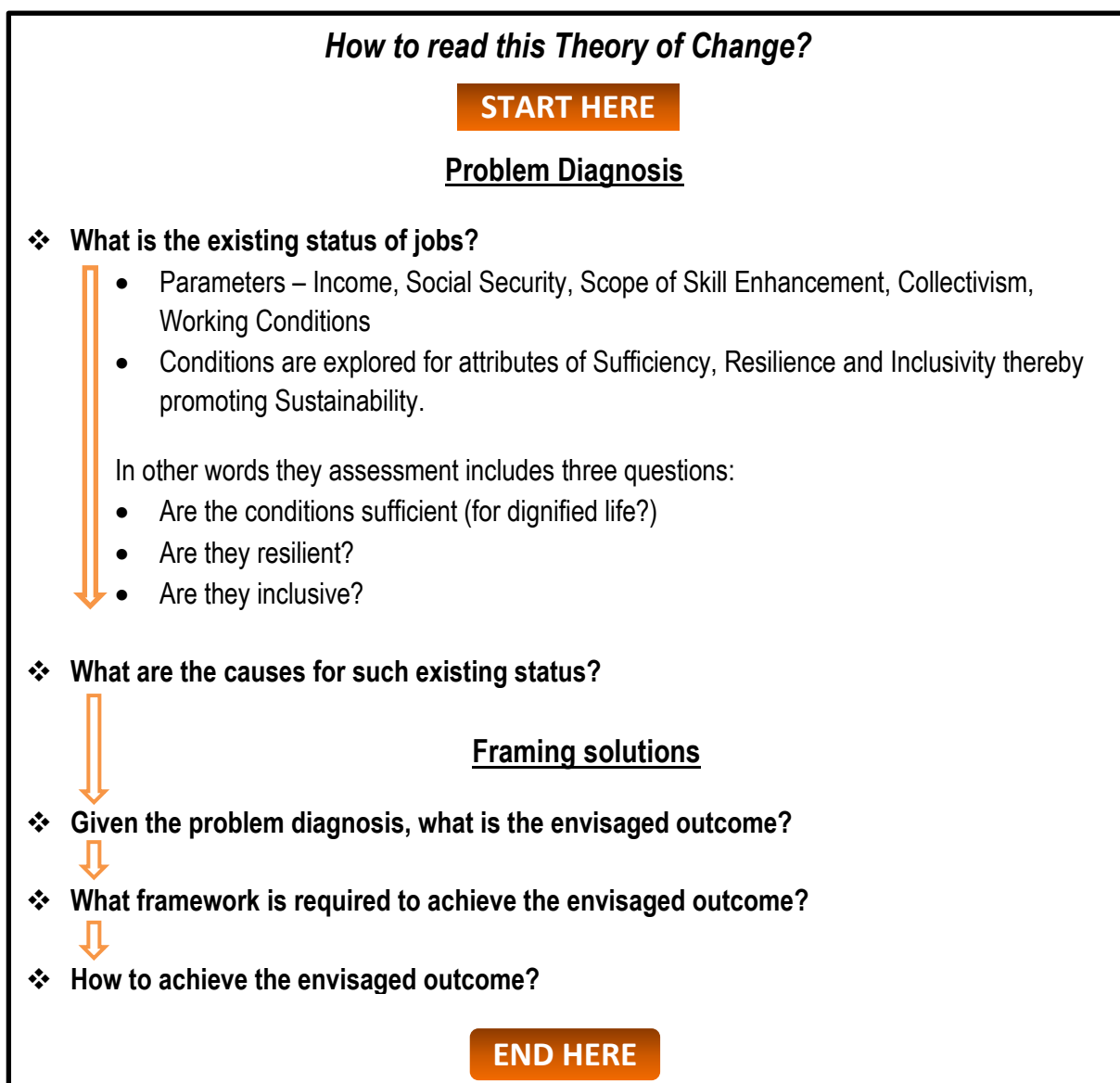
Theory of Change

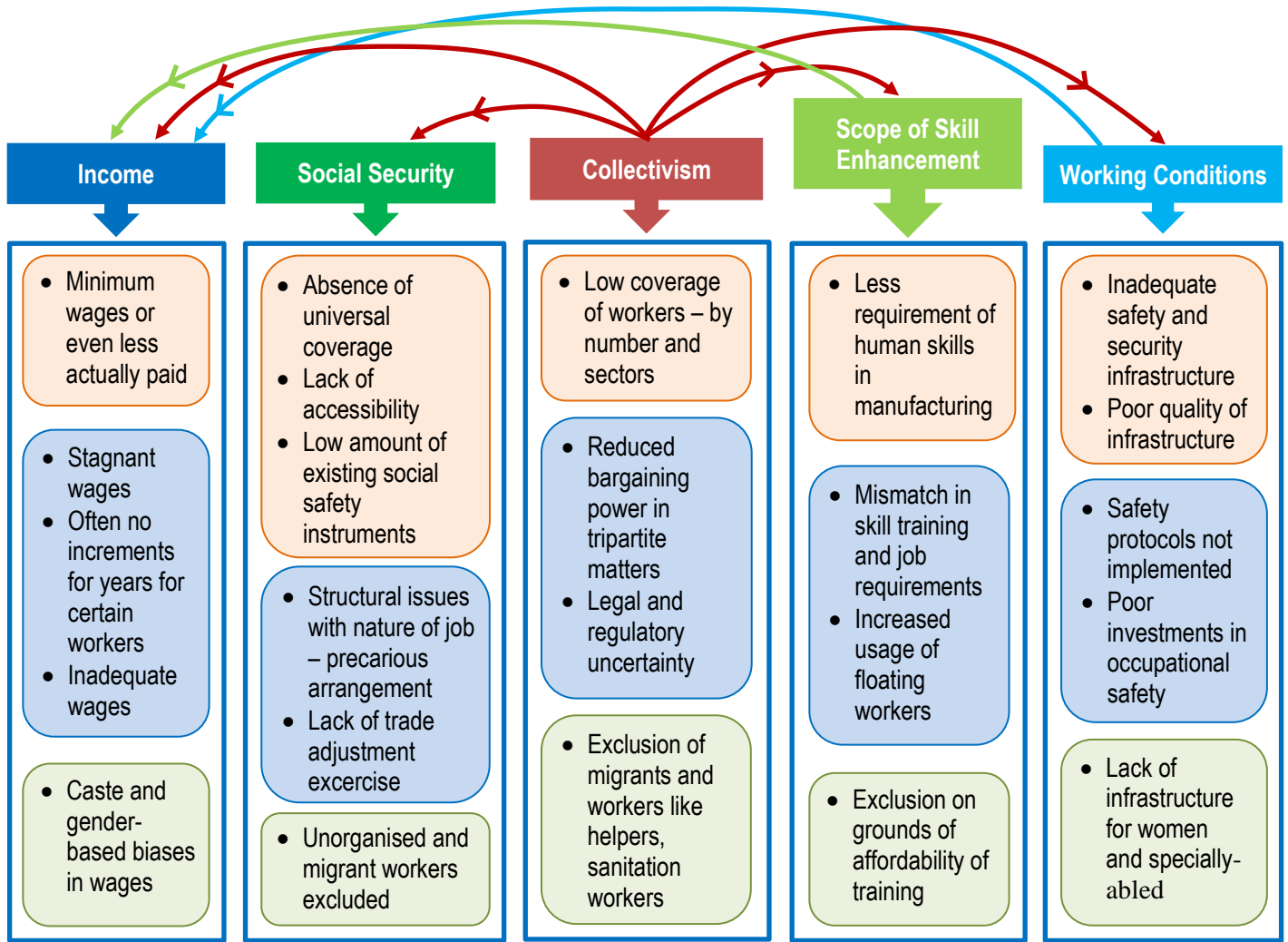

The following diagram provides an overview of the structure and key elements of this theory of change.

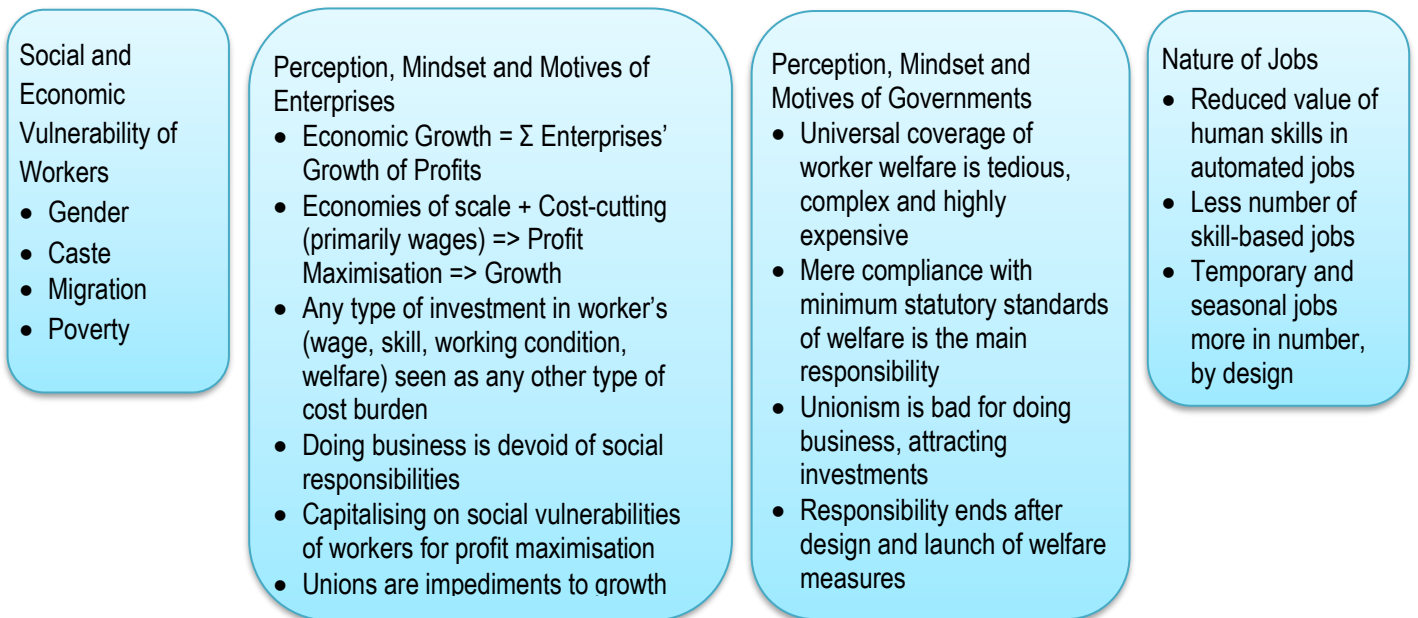


PROBLEM DIAGNOSIS

Exiting Status (Observations from the Ground)

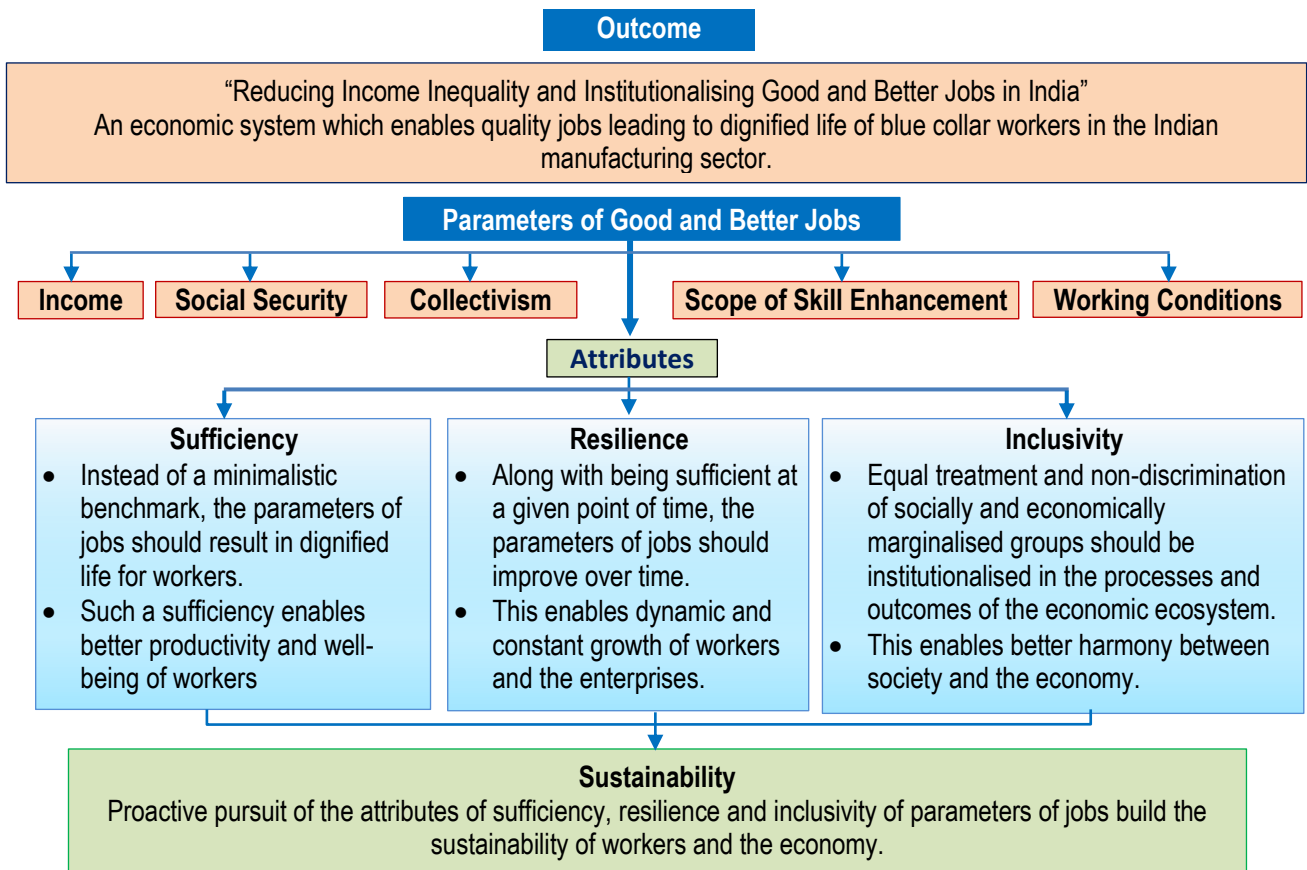


Causes of the Exiting Status

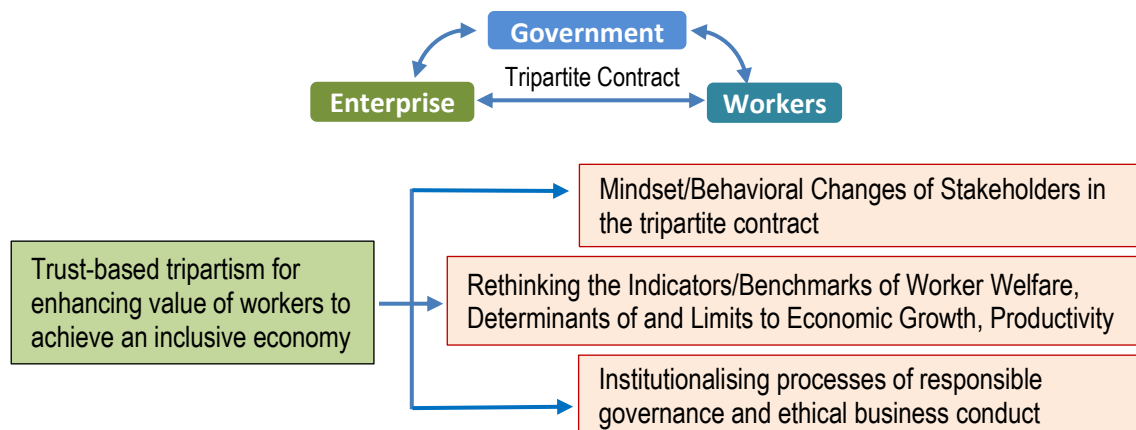

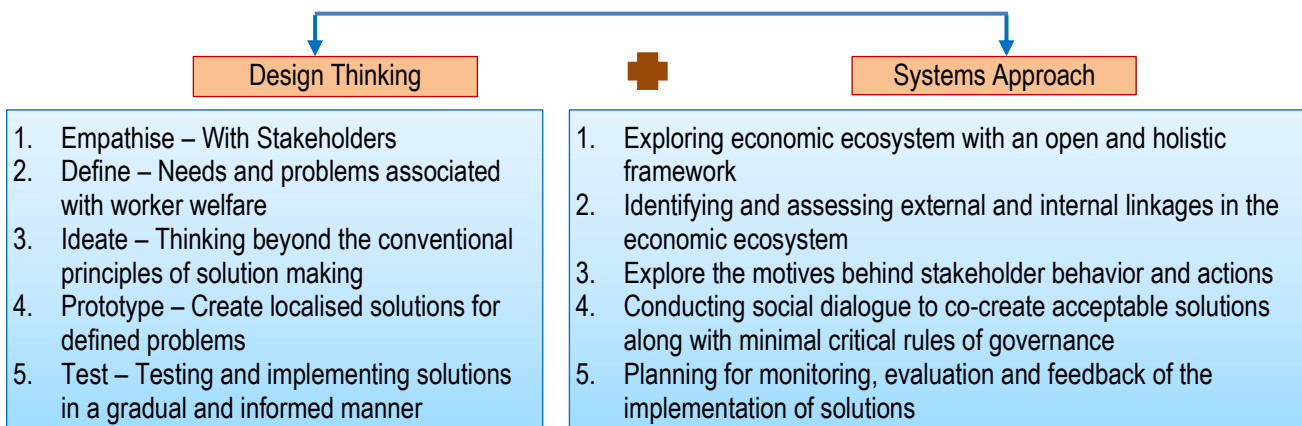
